Michael Klein is the President and Chief Executive Officer of IDQ Holdings – the world’s leading packager of automotive aftermarket air conditioning products. IDQ Holdings is based out of Garland, Texas and supplies valued customers such as Wal-Mart, AutoZone, Advance, O’Reillys and many others with quality products under the names of Interdynamics and Quest/EF Products.

Klein also served as CEO and President of Michigan-based Murray’s Discount Auto Stores (now a part of O’Reilly Automotive). He was associated with Murray’s from 1978 to early 2005. Over the years, he helped Murray’s grow from 6 Detroit-area stores to a chain of 109 auto parts superstores in Michigan, Ohio, Illinois, and Indiana. During his time there, Murray’s was generally regarded as the highest per-unit auto parts chain in America with average DIY (“Do-it-yourself”) store volumes and operating statistics twice the industry average.

Michael also serves on several committees and boards for a variety of nonprofit organizations. He currently is the Treasurer and serves on the Executive Board of Trustees for Leader Dogs for the Blind in Rochester Hills, Michigan. He chairs their Finance Committee and also serves on the Investment Committee. In addition, he is active with the Automotive Aftermarket Industry Association (“AAIA”). Klein is currently the Chairman of the AAIA’s Category Management Committee as well as the Investment Committee for the Board of Directors. He has also served the AAIA as a member of their Board of Directors and is a frequent guest speaker on automotive aftermarket and customer service topics.

Klein graduated with High Distinction in 1979 from Wayne State University in Detroit and holds a B.S. degree in business administration. Prior to joining Murray’s, Michael was a Certified Public Accountant and Certified Financial Planner with the Michigan firm of Gordon & Company.
