INDUSTRY AWARDS

AUTOMOTIVE LEADER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Award Criteria: This annual award, perceived as the industry's highest honor, recognizes a very significant individual who, while employed in the aftermarket, contributed to the industry in a unique and monumental way. Award winners need not be AWDA members.

Selection Committee: Composed of the previous five award winners who are willing and available to serve. The immediate past award winner serves as Committee Chairman.

ART FISHER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Award Criteria: This annual award, in memory of former AWDA Chairman Art Fisher, recognizes a company or individual for their leadership and commitment to education and training, either within their own organization or throughout the industry. Winners will be drawn from traditional industry participants including jobbers, distributors, manufacturers, AWDA members or non-members. Funds from the Art Fisher scholarship program shall be presented in the name of the award winner(s) to two undergraduate students enrolled in the automotive aftermarket management program at Northwood University, Midland, Mich.

Selection Committee: Current AWDA vice chairman (serves as Committee Chair); Fisher family member or appointee; Director, University of the Aftermarket; one previous award winner; at-large committee member from any industry segment appointed by chair.

PURSUIT OF EXCELLENCE AWARD

Award Criteria: This annual award, is presented exclusively to AWDA member companies or employees of those member companies, in recognition of excellence in business performance and the setting of high standards as an example for others to follow. AWDA Manufacturer members are a primary source for nominees within the distribution community.

Selection Committee: Current AWDA secretary (serves as Committee Chair); current AWDA MAC chairman; current AWDA MAC vice-chairman; one previous award winner; at-large committee member from any industry segment, appointed by chair.

MARTIN FROMM LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD
